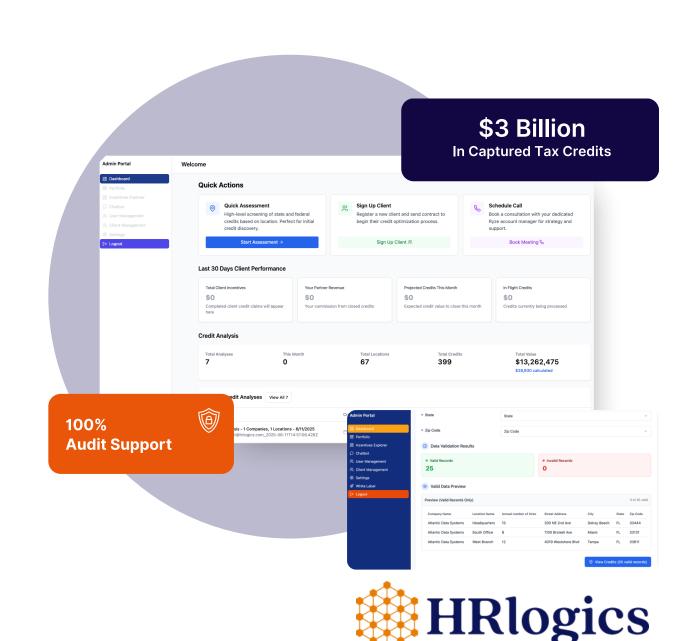

CURRENT LANDSCAPE:

WOTC, FEZ & Legislative Risk



- WOTC and FEZ are set to expire on 12/31/25
- FEZ credits are underutilized and misunderstood
- Many employers are unsure what actions to take next
- CPAs are waiting—some are unaware of alternatives

WOTC is a federal program that offers up to \$9,600 per hire for employing individuals from target groups like veterans, SNAP recipients, and the long-term unemployed.

Candidates must be screened on or before their start date.

WOTC will officially expire on December 31, 2025. Congress has not yet reauthorized it - but this isn't new.

- Since 2015, WOTC has been renewed three times
- The PATH Act retroactively covered prior hires
- Most expirations have led to full retroactive approvals

Pausing screening now could mean missing retroactive credits, potentially thousands per eligible hire.

History tells us reauthorization is likely. Screening today protects your ability to claim tomorrow. Tools like Ryze flag and hold candidates, so you're ready either way.

WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT FEZ

Underused, Still Active

- Apply to businesses in Empowerment Zones
- Must meet location and employee criteria
- Often missed due to lack of awareness
- Can be paired with WOTC when applicable
 - What counts as an Empowerment Zone?
 - What records do I need?
 - Why don't all CPAs bring this up?

WOTC is at risk - but your voice matters.

Know what to say (even if you're not "political")

WHY YOU SHOULD KEEP SCREENING

Even if WOTC is temporarily expired—you should not stop screening.

- Past expirations were followed by full retroactive approvals
- Stopping now could mean permanently losing credits for eligible hires
- Ryze flags and holds candidates automatically, so you're ready when renewal hits
- No downside: You're only billed based on actual credit totals no cost to screen during a hiatus
- Only upside: Continued screening now protects future savings

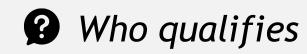
02.State Hiring Credits

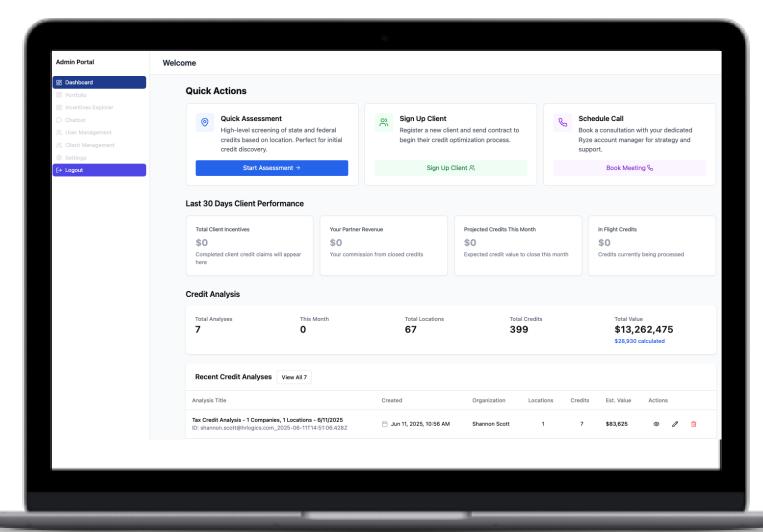

HOW TO TALK TO YOUR CPA

About Missed Credits

Not all accountants have time to research all the tax credits. To start a productive credit conversation, you need to know what to ask.
